Healthy Athletes® Health program

Special Olympics Healthy Athletes® global health program, made possible by the Golisano Foundation, is the largest global public health organization dedicated to serving people with intellectual disabilities.

- It consists of 7 different disciplines with 1 pilot discipline.
- The program offers free exams, consultations for therapies and distributes supplies to athletes.
- Athletes are examined in a warm and welcoming atmosphere.
- Healthy Athletes® opens the door to an optimal medical care as needed!
- Healthy Athletes provides an opportunity to follow-up care if needed.



This program focuses on the athletes' feet, inspects motion range and deformations, as well as skin and nail consistency. Shoes and socks are also inspected to fit athletes. Athletes are also educated about choosing the right shoes as well as proper foot and nail care.



This program aims to promote a healthy lifestyle. Health Promotion focuses on healthy living, healthy lifestyle choices, and specific health issues. The program also offers exams for bone density, blood pressure, and body mass index (BMI).

MedFest offers the physical exam that all athletes need prior to participating in Special Olympics sports programming. The exam consists of medical history. height and weight, blood pressure, cardiology and other tests.

This program is being introduced to the athletes as part of the World Winter Games 2017. Strong Minds will teach athletes mental exercises and provide resources to increase relaxation and stress management
