- To start cooperation with at least 5 other NGOs (FARE, CAFÉ, UNICEF ect)
- Secure the Government support to sports related social project administered by SO Moldova
- Reach 8 regions of Moldova with Special Olympics structure organize at least 1 conference/seminar in each region.
