




# Special Olympics Reach By Global Region

#### **2011 PROGRAM CENSUS SNAPSHOT**

In 2011, Special Olympics operated 225 accredited Programs in 170 countries; many of these Programs also managed comprehensive networks of local and regional Special Olympics clubs and teams.

This year, Special Olympics reached a major milestone of delivering sports, training, and competition opportunities to 4 million athletes around the world. Demonstrating our commitment to extending the reach of Special Olympics, in 2011 all seven Regions had positive athlete change. North America's Change Rate was only second to the Asia-Pacific Region at 6.7 percent and 13.6 percent, respectively. Additionally, the Asia-Pacific Region has now joined East-Asia to become the second Region to reach more than 1 million athletes and participants.

In addition to extending the reach of Special Olympics, 2011 marked important expansion in programs such as Unified Sports®, Healthy Athletes® and Young Athletes<sup>™</sup>, all in keeping with the ambitious goals set out in our Movement's 2011 – 2015 strategy.
