A celebration is held to recognize participating truckers and the support of the trucking industry.

Inspired by the powerful impact Special Olympics had on his life through his participating in the Law Enforcement Torch Run[®], combined with his family's involvement with the trucking industry, Norm Schneiderhan, a Corporal with the Orange County Sheriff's Department, created the Truck Convoy, a one-day celebration of the trucking industry to help raise awareness and funds for Special Olympics.
