- Host Town Program non-participants: 28 ~ 29 Jan

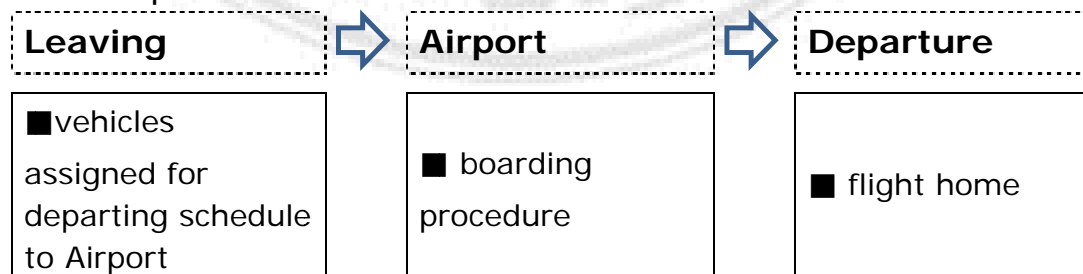
