- 6.1.2 Menus taking culture, religion, etc into account
- 6.1.3 Restaurants and facilities of accommodations as dining halls; lunch box or catering service at competition venues for lunch

6.2 Service Summary

- 6.2.1 Service from 28 Jan ~ 6 Feb 2013 taking HTP nonparticipants and departing dates into account
- 6.2.2 10,000 delegations, staff and volunteers entitled to the service (estimate)
- 6.2.3 Restaurants and facilities of lodging facilities for breakfast and supper
 - 6.2.3.1 Possible temporary cafeteria at competition venues for lunch; lunch box
- 6.2.4 Each lodging facility to be commissioned to run the service under GOC's supervision

6.3 Service for Delegations, SOI, TOs, etc.

- 6.3.1 Service for athletes, coaches, officials, SOI, technical officials
- 6.3.2 Breakfast & supper at dining facilities of accommodations and lunch at onsite operation
- 6.3.3 Beverage to be provided at competition venues, lounge, lodging facilities, event venues
- 6.3.4 Menus considering budget and SOI guideline,
