Special Olympics East Asia Unified Schools Memorandum of Understanding

This Unified Schools Memorandum of Understanding (this “MOU”) is entered into on October xxxxx, 2015 by and between:

Special Olympics provides year-round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities, giving them continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in a sharing of gifts, skills and friendship with their families, other Special Olympics athletes and the community.

Through Unified Schools Program, a sports and education combined program, Special Olympics will contribute to promote school communities where all young people are agents of change – fostering respect, dignity and advocacy for people with intellectual disabilities.

For the purpose of promotion and collaboration on Special Olympics East Asia Unified Schools Program and on the basis of voluntariness, equality, mutual benefit and good faith, the three Parties agree as follows:

Party A`s Duties and Obligations:

1. Party A shall host Special Olympics Unified Sports activity at its campus at least once every year by inviting the Special Olympics athletes from Party B and their families. The activity shall be no less than 90 minutes. If Party C sponsors the activity, Party A shall provide the activity budget plan to Party C prior to the activity implementation. The activity agreement needs to be entered into between Party A and Party C. Party A shall provide the entire activity related receipts and finance breakdown to Party C for its review and verification after the activity completion.

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2. Party A shall recruit and train 80 students as Special Olympics volunteers and unified partners who shall participate in Special Olympics Unified Sports activities twice every year.
3. Party A shall offer the opportunities for its students to serve the Special Olympics activities facilitated by Party C.
4. Be willing to work with Party B to select 5-10 outstanding student leaders to serve as the mentors of Special Olympics athletes from Party B.
5. Encourage its students to participate in various Special Olympics activities facilitated by Party C.
6. Arrange students to be responsible for photograph and video recording for the activities and provide the activity image data to Party C for publicity and file. Party A shall also regularly provide the compelling stories of student volunteers and unified partners and Special Olympics athletes to Party C for the purpose of publicity.
7. Party A shall provide annual report of Special Olympics activities to Party C with basic information including but not limited to participant structure, participant number, photos and video documents. 10 sampling survey questionnaires on Unified Sports from students and their families shall be collected and provided to Party C for helping the program improvement.
8. Utilize the school publicity channels such as school web site, social media etc. to promote Special Olympics and its associated activities.

Party B`s Duties and Obligations:

1. Party B shall host Special Olympics Unified Sports activity at its campus at least once every year by inviting the student partners from Party A and their families. The activity shall be no less than 90 minutes. If Party C sponsors the activity, Party B shall provide the activity budget plan to Party C prior to the activity implementation. The activity agreement needs to be entered into between Party B and Party C. Party B shall provide the entire activity related receipts and finance breakdown to Party C for its review and verification after the activity completion.
2. Party B shall offer volunteer service opportunities for the students from Party A and regularly provide the compelling stories of student volunteers and unified partners and Special Olympics athletes to Party C for the purpose of publicity.
3. Assist Party C to provide Special Olympics training to the teachers and students from Party A as well as recruit student volunteers.
4. Assist Party A and Party C to lay down Unified Sports activity implementation plan.
5. Support and assist Party A to select outstanding student leaders to be the mentor of Special Olympics athletes.
6. Work with Party A to actively participate in the Special Olympics activities facilitated by Party C.
7. Party B shall provide annual report of Special Olympics activities to Party C with basic information including but not limited to participant structure, participant number, photos and video documents. 10 sampling survey questionnaires on Unified Sports from students

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and their families shall be collected and provided to Party C for helping the program improvement.

Party C`s Duties and Obligations:

1. Coordinate between Party A and Party B to establish and maintain partnership among three Parties.
2. Provide Special Olympics technical support and organize trainings to the teachers and students from Party A and Party B.
3. Provide Unified Sports activity seed grant to Party A and Party B and assist to lay down the Unified Sports activity implementation plan.
4. Coordinate Party A and Party B to compile annual activity report and financial report to ensure the report reasonable, transparency and completed.
5. Party C reserves the right of approval for identifying appropriate Special Olympics athletes, volunteers and unified partners from Party A and Party B to participate in the Special Olympics activities, so as to ensure the participant qualification.

In the event of any matters and disputes arising out of or in connection with the MOU, the parties shall attempt to resolve the disputes through friendly consultation.

The Parties have caused their authorized representatives to execute this MOU on the date first written above, with immediate effect.

This MOU is made in three (3) originals, with each Party holding one (1) original. All the originals have the same force and effect.
