The pictures are located on the left-hand side of the page	
The font size is at least 14 points	
The spacing is at least 1.5	
There are 15 words or less per sentence	
There are 3-7 sentences per paragraph	
There are subheadings	
There are page numbers located at the bottom right-hand side of	
the page	
There are clear line breaks

The review group consisted of at least 3 people in the target	
audience	
The host of the review group went through the review questions
