

- Fit Feet (podiatry)
- FUNfitness (physical therapy)
- Health Promotion (better health and well-being)
- Healthy Hearing (audiology)
- Special Olympics-Lions Clubs International Opening Eyes (vision)
- Special Smiles (dentistry)
- Strong Minds (emotional well-being)



LAW ENFORCEMENT TORCH RUN® In the days leading up to the Games, The Special Olympics Flame of hope® will tour close to 50 cities around Sweden, before arriving at the Opening Ceremony of the World Winter Games.
