G - 7	Law Enforcement Torch Run Final Leg commences in the hosts nation
G - 5	Delegations arrive the Host Town Program begins
G - 2	Host Town Program ends, Delegations check-in at their Games-time accommodation and non-sports activities launch (e.g. Special Olympics Festival, Global Youth Activation Summit)
G - 1	Preliminary competition begins and Special Olympics International conducts its Board of Directors Meeting and Dinner
G - 0	OPENING CEREMONY
G+1 TO G+6	Competition, Awards Ceremonies and non-sports activities (e.g. receptions, policy events, etc.)
G + 7	CLOSING CEREMONY
G + 8	Delegations depart
