


# Advanced Exporter

This tool allows you to select fields to be exported and send that data into an export file that you can use in other programs.

## How to Use the Advanced Exporter

From the **User tools** panel, select **Advanced exporter**. This action can be completed both within a Games and universally.

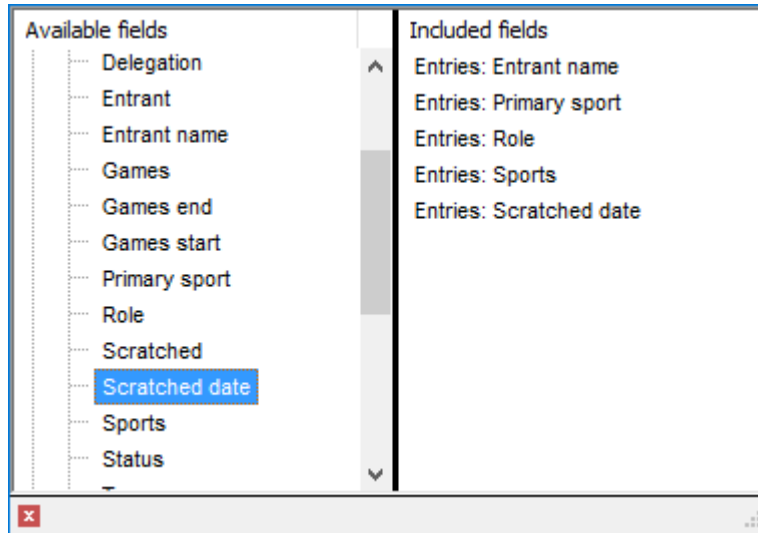

**Initial source:** Use this dropdown to select the basis for the export, whether it be people, certifications, credentials, etc.

**Fields to include:** Use this section to specify which fields should be included in the export. The fields are organized into groups. At the fields level, you can drag and drop the field name from the left-hand **Available fields** list to the right-hand **Included fields** list.



**Exclude people with these flags:** Use this section to exclude data by flags.

**Filters:** Use this series of checkboxes to set the exported data filters. You may add more filters by selecting the **Add another filter** link.

When you have finished setting your exporter criteria, select **Export** to complete your export.
