

Key features/compo nents	User-friendly, comprehensive and allows for creating a stakeholder profile.
Benefits	It will help Programs in identifying priority partners to start with based on the needs of their community and the Programs strategic priorities.

Title	Leveraging and Strengthening Existing Partnerships
Description	A resource designed to help Programs optimize and leverage existing partnerships to enhance health system strengthening and policy change.
Objective	The primary objective is to equip Programs with skills and tools needed to identify top priority partnerships and leverage/strengthen them to achieve health system change.
Key	An assessment component to enable Programs assess strategic relevance of the
features/compo	partnerships in achieving health system change and prioritize
nents	partners/partnerships.
Benefits	It will help Programs to optimize resources and focus on partnerships that have potential in influencing health system change.



Title	Partnerships and Collaborations for Health System Strengthening Database
Description Objective	Based on the information and data generated from the SHE Collaborations List (as well as partnership spectrum and stakeholder mapping), a comprehensive database will be created to help SOI and regions analyse partnerships and collaborations and identify potential opportunities and optimize them. To create a pilot database and have all collaboration/partnerships related information.
Key features/com ponents	Partner profile, list of partners per region and country. Captures regional and global partners. Search and filter capabilities. User-friendly, centralized with access granted to concerned parties.
Benefits	Better follow up and tracking of partnerships, helps in reporting and planning. Generate stories or posts for the webpage. Metrics tracking.



Title	Roadmap Resource to Integrate SO IDD Inclusive Curriculum into Health Professions Education
Description	A Resource/tool designed to help Programs in the effort of identifying and promoting the adoption of SO IDD inclusive health curriculum by universities and accreditation bodies.
Objective	To increase the number of Programs promoting SO IH curriculum and to leverage existing efforts.
Key features/componen ts	Roadmap document, dynamic and adaptable depending on the context and needs. Shares step by step information on promoting adoption, identifying universities or accreditation bodies, and good practices from Programs around the world.
Benefits	Time saving as the resource will include templates, forms, and email drafts.



Title	Community Health Workers Strategy: background and way forward to increasing uptake of SO ID training for CHWs
Description	A set of sessions to provide Programs with background on CHWs work in their region and to provide Programs with information on where to find/look for organizations that employ CHWs for their operations.
Objective	To provide Programs with needed skills and information to increase partnerships/collaborations with organizations that emlpoy CHWs and therefore increase uptake of SO ID training for CHWs
Key features/componen ts	Host a partner to explain more about CHW work and field of operations/duties. 1-pager on SO ID training for CHWs and an email template to be used by Programs.
Benefits	Increase uptake of the training, more CHWs will be trained on ID and strengthened collaborations.


