Only **50%** of people report that their city/area is a good place for people with intellectual disabilities.



79%

of Unified football partners reported their understanding of people with intellectual disabilities improved after participating in Special Olympics.

In Japan and China, only 17% of people believe that people with intellectual disabilities are very capable of participating in sports with other people with intellectual disabilities.



65% of parents

report that Special Olympics had **raised their expectations** of their children who participated in Special Olympics.



Despite 85% of people with intellectual disabilities being only mildly impaired, there is a widespread belief that they are not capable of being included in sports or school activities.
