Both riders must race the divisioning event and the final. No change in riders is permitted. Both riders may be held at the start. The event is held on the same course as the individual Time Trial Course. The team is scored as “finished” when the leading edge of the front tire of the second rider crosses the finish line. Both team members must finish within five (5) seconds of each other to be scored as having “finished.” Time standards shall be permitted. Time standards will be set by the technical director in consultation with the officials.</p>
