3.2.1.3 Two tie break 6 game sets using no-ad scoring with a 10 point match tie break to decide the match. In a 6 game set the first player/team who wins 6 games with a margin of two games wins the set. A 7-point tie-break shall be played at six games all. When the score in a match is one set all, one 10-point tie-break game shall be played to decide the match. This tie break game replaces the deciding final set. Not recommended for athletes with an ITN higher than 6.
3.1.2.4 In the two tie break 4 game or 6 game sets, there will be a three-minute rest period prior to the deciding 10-point tie-break.
3.1.2.5 The No-Ad scoring system will be used for all match play. The No-Ad procedure is simply what the name implies: The first player to win four points wins the game, with the seventh point of a game becoming a game point for each player

This tie break game replaces the deciding final set. Not recommended for athletes with an ITN higher than 6 .

3.3 No-AD Scoring
3.3.1 Singles Matches
3.3.1.1 The receiver has the choice of advantage court or deuce court, the service on the seventh point, is to be delivered to the nominated court.
Doubles Matches
The receiving pair has the choice of advantage court or deuce court, the service on the seventh point, is to be delivered to player playing in the nominated court.
Mixed Doubles Matches
The player of the same gender as the server shall receive the deciding point. i.e. male to male or female to female.
Unified Doubles Matches
The service on the seventh point is to be delivered athlete to athlete or partner to partner.
Score Calling
The score calling may be either in the conventional terms or simple
