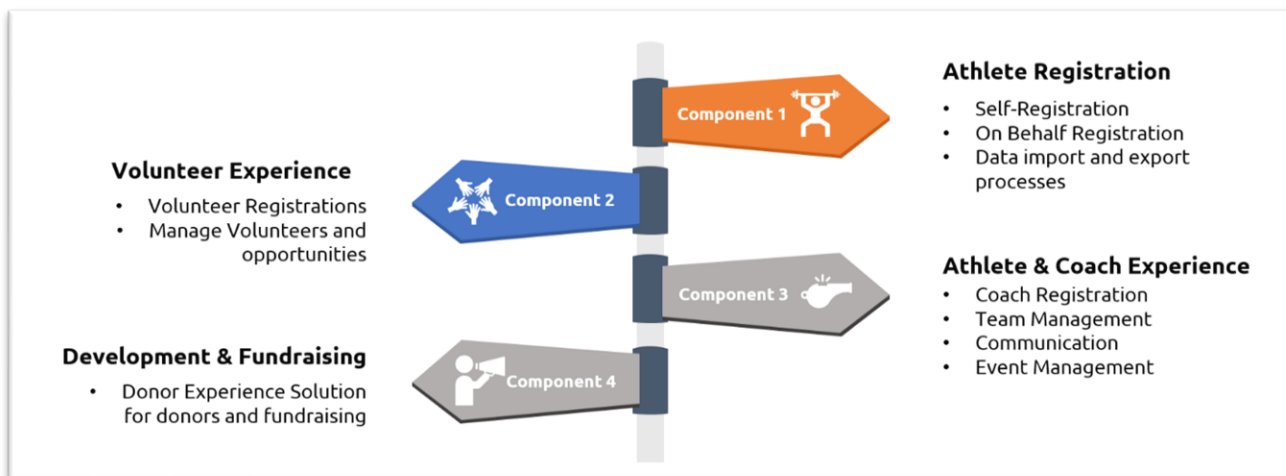




## What is the COE?
