



To provide year-round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities, giving them continuing opportunities to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, experience joy and participate in a sharing of gifts, skills and friendship with their families, other Special Olympics athletes and the community.

Special Olympics is a global movement of people creating a new world of inclusion and community, where every single person is accepted and welcomed, regardless of ability or disability. We are helping to make the world a better, healthier and more joyful place - one athlete, one volunteer, one family member at a time.









Sport continues to be at the center of Special Olympics - and we will use this catalyst to increase education to include the population of people with intellectual disabilities, the population Special Olympics primarily serves.

Following the 2019 Africa Region increase in the number of accredited countries, the Africa Region had to adapt to this sudden increase considering that approximately 45% of the current 41 accredited countries are in the emerging status.

With such disparities with 65% of the accredited countries in the advanced status, a hybrid local Program

Development approach has been employed ensuring adjusted training Programs to achieve the same goal: local Program Development.

LOCAL PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

There has been an increase in onsite coaches and Board governance training, and this has paid off well as there is evidence of Special Olympics Programs sustaining stable good governance and significant increase in the recruitment of new athletes and the recovery of previously missing athletes and coaches from the pandemic.

With the changing global priorities, and to keep in sync with the current global trends, digital technology will be a priority in the coming years in the Africa Region.



PIONEER PARTNER

The 'A Very Special Christmas' albums, created by world renowned musical artists, producers and A&M Records, launched the first album launched in 1987.

In 2017, over \$3 million was allocated by the Christmas Records Trust to support Program Development and fund Christmas Record Grants.

These grants were used to recruit athletes, train coaches, host competitions, and expand athlete and partner participation in Unified Sports.

Since 1998, over \$70 million has been given to Special Olympics Programs from the Christmas Records Trust.





GLOBAL COALITION FOR INCLUSION

Glad to announce that another important area of focus in the coming years will be the Special Olympics Global Coalition for Inclusion, made possible through the generous grant from the Stavros Niarchos Foundation (SNF). The Coalition is a multilateral effort that engages national governments to support in-country expansion of Special Olympics inclusive education through sports programming Unified Sports and Unified Schools.

The Coalition aims to collaborate closely with national governments as well as foreign aid agencies, UN agencies, industry leaders, global philanthropy and international non-governmental organizations to invest in inclusive education through sports as a key way for nations to fully implement the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UN-CRPD) and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN-SDGs).

Strategically, we would like to position national governments to become members of the Coalition, and we look to match the funding that SNF is providing to Special Olympics as a commitment to scaling this important work.

The Coalition was launched globally during the 2023 Special Olympics World Summer Games in Berlin, and we witnessed several national governments from around the world that signed to join the Global Coalition for Inclusion. To date, five of these are from the Africa Region:

- The Republic of Angola
- The Republic of Ghana
- The Republic of Kenya
- The Republic of Seychelles
- The Republic of South Africa

We launched the Coalition in Ghana on the 27 November 2023 and in Seychelles on 4 December 2023. We will be launching the Global Coalition in Angola, Kenya and in South Africa on the dates to be announced. His Excellency Cyril Ramaphosa, President of the Republic of South Africa, recently committed to the Global Coalition for Inclusion in his speech when he welcomed the 2023 Special Olympics World Games delegation to a celebratory event at the Union Buildings in Pretoria.



DEFINITIONS:

UNIFIED SPORTS: Special Olympics Sports programming in which people with ID (Unified Athletes) and without ID (Unified Partners) train and compete together as teammates.

UNIFIED SCHOOLS: a school or university that conducts Unified Sports opportunities at least 2 times within a calendar year.

UNIFIED CHAMPION SCHOOLS®: a program for schools Pre-K through university that promotes meaningful social inclusion utilizing 3 interconnected components: Unified Sports®, inclusive youth leadership, and whole school engagement.

YOUNG ATHLETES: a sport and play program for children with and without intellectual disabilities (ID), ages 2 to 7 years old.

HEALTHY COMMUNITIES: a Special Olympics recognition program working to increase access to quality health care and effective prevention programming to improve the health of people with intellectual disabilities through activating public and private sector partners to adopt more inclusive practices, training and empowering athletes and caregivers to become vocal advocates.

PROGRAM: qualified entity licensed and accredited by Special Olympics International to operate Special Olympics programming within their respective geographic territory (country, jurisdiction or U.S. state).

LOCAL CLUB / SUB-PROGRAM: an organized local unit / branch conducting Special Olympics activities in a community outside of a school setting.

MOTOR ACTIVITY TRAINING PROGRAM (MATP): is designed for individuals with intellectual disabilities with severe limitations who do not yet possess the physical and/or behavioral skills necessary to participate in official Special Olympics sports.

Why Inclusive Health Matters Now More Than Ever

The most important risk for people with ID is not their underlying health conditions, but their lack of access to healthcare. In addition, more than 80% of healthcare providers are not trained to treat people with intellectual disabilities.

Despite severe need and higher health risks, people with intellectual disabilities lack equitable access to health services and die, on average, 16 years earlier than the general population.

Special Olympics Zimbabwe Health

Messenger Barbara Njovo was invited to speak at the World Health Summit session "Reimagining Universal Health Coverage to Leave No One Behind: Health Equity for Persons with Disabilities and Access to Assistive Technology as Key Drivers to Achieving Universal Health Coverage."

Special Olympics, as part of a disability-inclusive health consortium that included ATScale, the Global Partnership for Assistive Technology, Christian Blind Mission, Clinton Health Access Initiative, Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), and Missing Billion Initiative, made a strong impression at the recent World Health Summit (WHS) held in Berlin. One of the world's premiere global health events, the WHS enjoys high-level attendance — from global health players like the World Health Organization, national governments and civil society.







The impact of global youth work is playing an increasingly vital role in the work of Special Olympics, and Africa Region is leading the way.

Key achievements from Africa Region, as published in the Special Olympics Global Youth Engagement 2022 and 2023 Impact Report, have been across the several focus areas of Unified Schools, inclusive Youth Leadership development and Special Olympics Young Athletes.


