Established in 1968, Special Olympics is a global movement dedicated to empowering athletes with intellectual disabilities, working with hundreds of thousands of volunteers and coaches each year across the world.

Special Olympics provides year-round sports training and athletic competition in a variety of Olympic-type sports for children and adults with intellectual disabilities. These activities create continuous opportunities for athletes to develop physical fitness, demonstrate courage, build confidence, and experience joy, inclusion, and lasting friendships.

Special Olympics Bangladesh officially established in 1994. It is registered as a NGO under NGO affairs bureau, government of Bangladesh.
