

Chapter 7: Safety and Security

7.1 Basic policy of the safety and security of the Games

The 2013 GOC will carry out security check at the entrances of Athlete Villages and indoor stadiums by hiring a private security firm under the leadership of the Security Director.

As for anti-terrorism activities, standing a guard, firefighting and safety activities for facilities, Security Director will cooperation with related agencies such as the Police.

7.2 Operating plan of security situation room

7.2.1 Pyeongchang security situation room will be located in athlete village of Alpensia and run 24/7. And the GOC, the police and fire station will jointly carry out safety activities like standing a guard, firefighting, rescue, emergency activities and screening.

7.2.2 Gangneung security situation room will be located in athlete village of Gwandong University and run 24/7. And the GOC, the police and fire station will jointly carry out safety activities like standing a guard, firefighting, rescue, emergency activities and screening.

7.2.3 Venue security control room will be established in every sports venue. Agencies to make a quick response on site will dispatch agents to the venues.

7.3 Entrance security check of athletes villages

Devices of security check such as X-ray, Metal Detectors(MD) and scanning agents will be set up at the entrance of athletes villages and indoor stadiums to check

- if a person wears valid credential
- if a person brings dangerous substances including guns, knives and the flammable with
- if an athlete goes out without accompanying with a coach or staff

But security check at entrances could be loosened or tightened based on the information related to safety and security of the Games.

7.4 Guarding venues and escorting key persons

The police will be placed at every venue for patrolling and keeping an order. But escorting using vehicles will be decided based on consultation with Transportation team.

7.5 Escorting key persons

- Chief of the state such as president or king will be escorted by Presidential Security Service.
- Former chiefs of the state and spouses of current chiefs of the state will be escorted by the National Police Agency.
- Other VIPS will be escorted by private security agents based on discussion between the GOC and SOI.

7.6 Fire Fighting

Fire fighters will be placed at athletes villages and sports venues. And they will put out fires using fireplug and fire extinguishing team on standby around athletes villages and sports venues will quickly move in case of fire.

7.7 Rescue and Emergency

Emergency team will stand by 24/7 at athletes villages to take measures for patients. Emergency team at sports venue will be placed during competitions to rescue the injured and transfer them to hospitals. In order for rapid transfer of

patients, helicopter will stand by at Alpensia.

Note: Rescue helicopters and ambulances are operated without charge in Korea.

7.8 Safety check of the Games facilities

Related authorities will carry out safety check for the Games facilities including athlete villages and sports venues.

Owner of the facilities and related agencies such as Korea Electrical Safety Corporation and Korea Gas Safety Corporation will cooperate to carry out safety checks of water supply, air control system, electricity and gas.

Comprehensive safety checks will be carried out before the Games and daily safety checks will also be conducted during the Games to respond to emergencies.

7.9 Request

Delegations should adhere to laws of the Republic of Korea.

In particular,

- No carrying weapons such as gun or rifle.

- No illegal staying and doing activities other than the original purpose of entry to Korea
- Full cooperation with law enforcement authorities to keep and order

For the athletes' own safety, athletes should move accompanying with coaches or staffs and make a quick report to security situation room when safety problems occur.
