Chapter 8: Medical Services

8.1 Introduction

8.1.1 Functional Goal

To provide efficient medical treatments to all participants throughout the Games in the event of emergencies

8.1.2 Basic Policy

- Operate a central medical situation room and medical facilities in the Games areas and other related areas; and to provide effective and timely treatments to all Games participants
- Establish an efficient system to transfer patients in a case of emergency
- Use the Medical Encounter System (MES) to track medical incidents of all Games participants

8.2 Establishment of Medical Service System

8.2.1. Medical Service System

■ GOC ←→ Designated Hospitals: MOU contract

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 Designated Hospitals: Receives and treats patients that require the care of specialists

8.3 Operating Plans for Medical Facilities

8.3.1. First-Aid Station in Game Areas

- Operation Period: Jan. 29th Feb. 5th (8 days)
- Location: All games venues (eight stations)
- Functions: Provides first-aid treatments to athletes, officials, press members, operation staff and spectators
- Medical Personnel: Eight(8) staff per station

8.3.2. Central Medical Situation Room

- Operation Period: Jan. 26th Feb. 6th (12 days)
- Location: Alpensia Convention Center
- Functions: Manages and operates all medical services and patient transportation
- Medical Personnel: Fourteen(14) staff

8.3.3. First-aid Station in Athlete's Village

- Operation Period: Jan. 29th Feb. 6th (9 days)
- Location: Gangneung-Wonju National University & Kwandong University Dormitories (2 stations)
- Functions: Provides first-aid treatments to athletes and officials

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Medical Personnel: Nine staff per station

8.3.4. Designated Hospitals



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- Operation Period: Jan. 26th Feb. 6th (12 days)
- Major hospitals in the Area including major medical center in Seoul (8 hospitals)

8.5 Prevention of Contagious Diseases

- Operation Period: Jan. 26th Feb. 5th (11 days)
- Basic Policy:
- Conduct surveillance and quarantine activities against contagious diseases throughout the Games
- Facilities subject to preventive measures: Games venues and accommodation facilities

8.6 Patience Record Management

- 8.6.1 MES(Medical Encounter System) Operation
 - Central Medical Center: Control & Manage MES
 - Oversee all medical facilities for MES management
 - Back-up and manage all daily medical services
 - All medical facilities: Record all patience treatments to MES
 - Retrieve patience's medical records for a proper treatment
